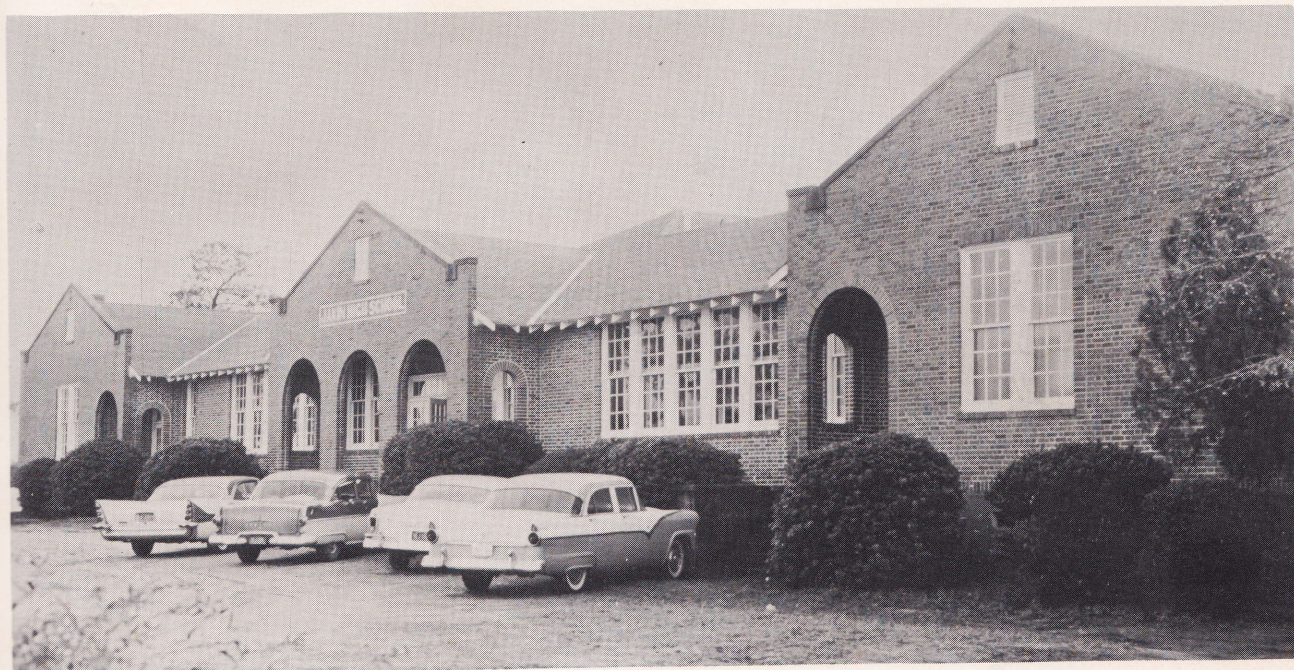

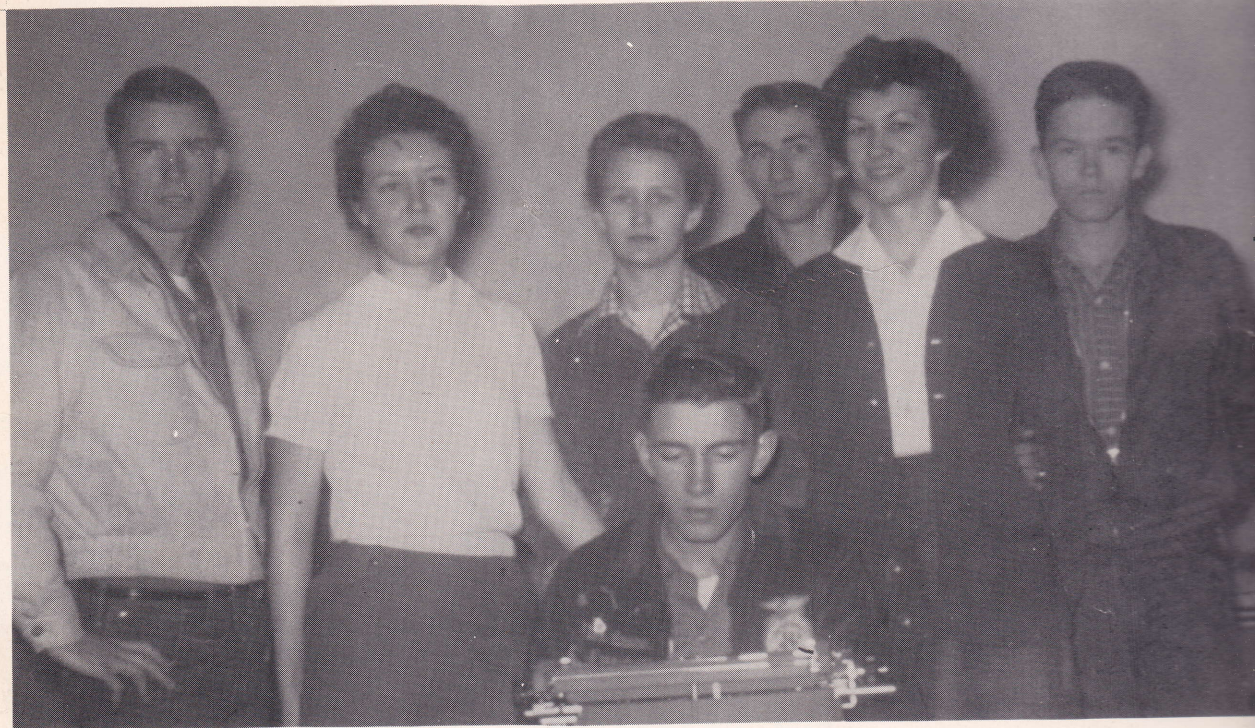

As you leave us and journey on through life may your memory of your teachers and the Jakin High School always be one of affection.

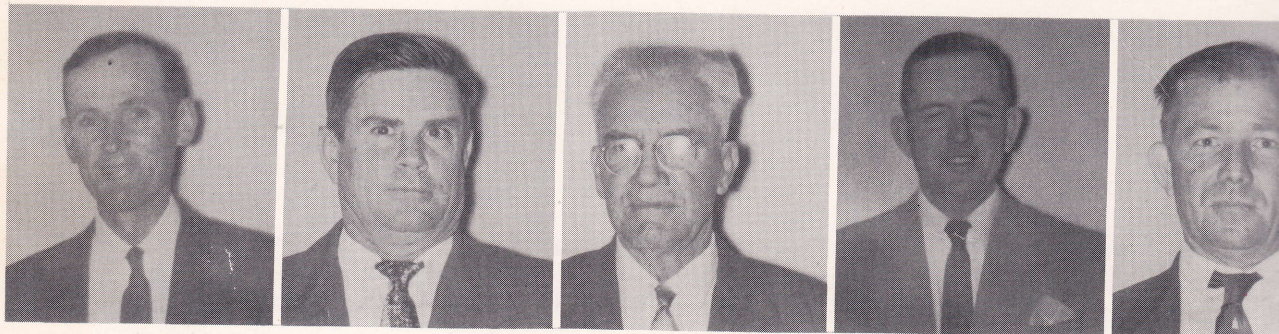

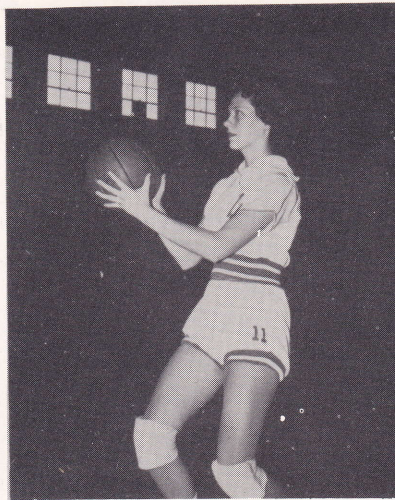
Well, I have to go back to Earth now. Good-bye everyone! See you at the next reunion on the second start north of Pluto. Be sure and be there.
