BRIEF HISTORY OF JAKIN SCHOOL

In 1921 Midway School was consolidated with Jakin School. A two-story brick building was erected in Jakin. The only water available was an outside hand pump. There was a need to transport students due to the larger school district. The first school bus was used in 1928-29.

In June of 1932, the school building burned. A larger building was started that same year. Classes were held in churches and other available buildings until the new building was completed. In 1934 another grade was added, making eleven grades.

Home Economics and Vocational Agricultural Departments were added in 1937 and additional rooms plus a two-room building were erected.

The Springfield School burned in 1942 and a large part of that district was added to Jakin. A new agricultural building was erected and the old one was used by the Grammar School, with two rooms added.

In the early 1940's, a water system was installed and a canning plant was built on campus. Parents cooperated with teachers and added a lunchroom to the canning plant in 1947. A new kitchen was added in 1948.

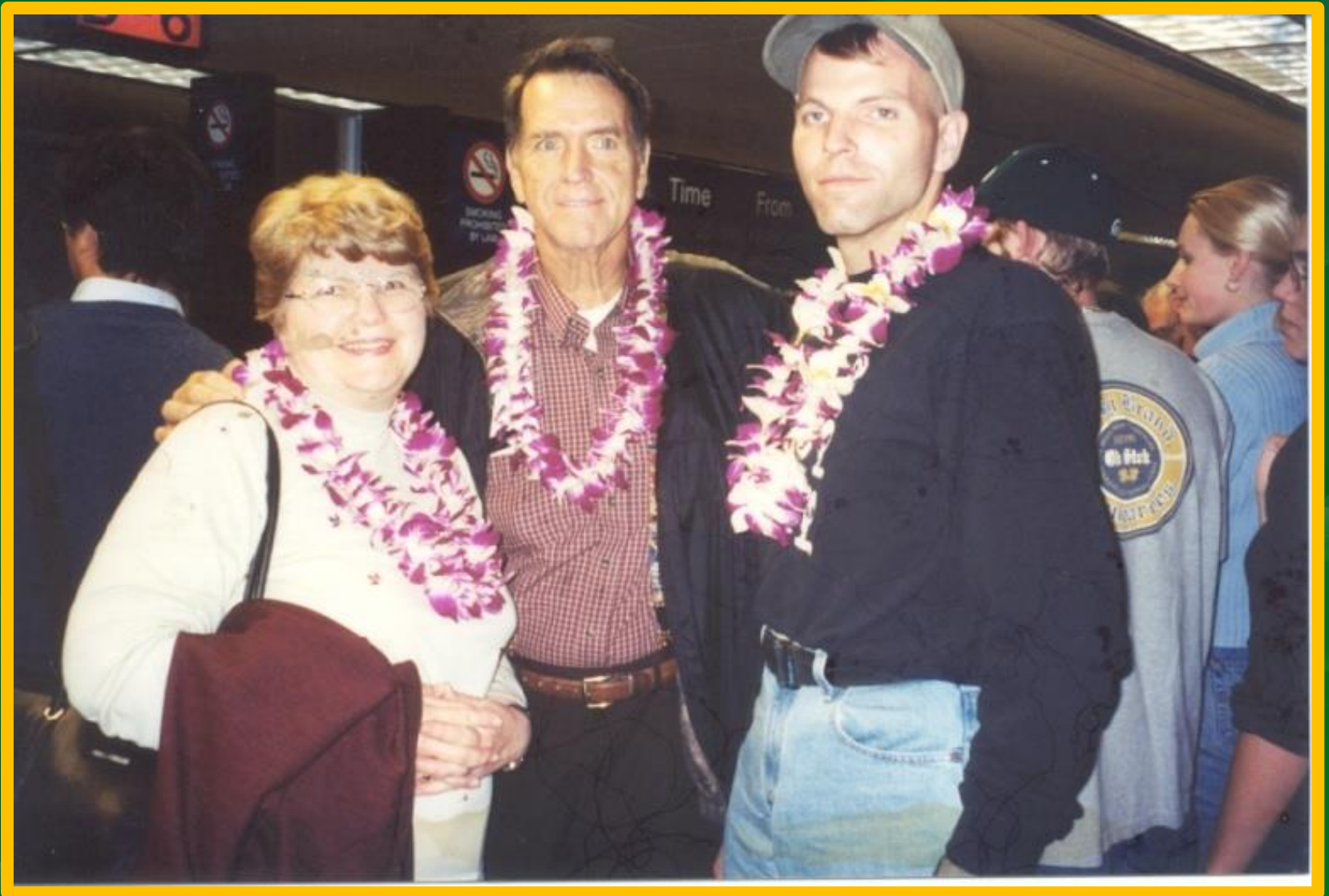
It was announced in 1949 that a Commercial Course would be taught for the first time. Street lights were also added that year. In 1952, the twelvth grade was added.

In 1955 a brick gymnasium was erected on the south end of the campus. A new larger lunchroom was erected in 1956.

Through the years, teachers, parents and other supporters struggled to maintain the Jakin School, even serving a Sunday noon meal in the lunchroom during 1963 to pay one teachers salary.

In spite of all the efforts of the Jakin Community, the school did not survive. The high school was consolidated with Early County High School in Blakely after the 1963 school year and the grammar school in 1966. After those years some students were granted permission to attend Seminole County High School in Donalsonville; and this is still being done. Other students were picked up by buses and transported to Blakely and this is still the policy.

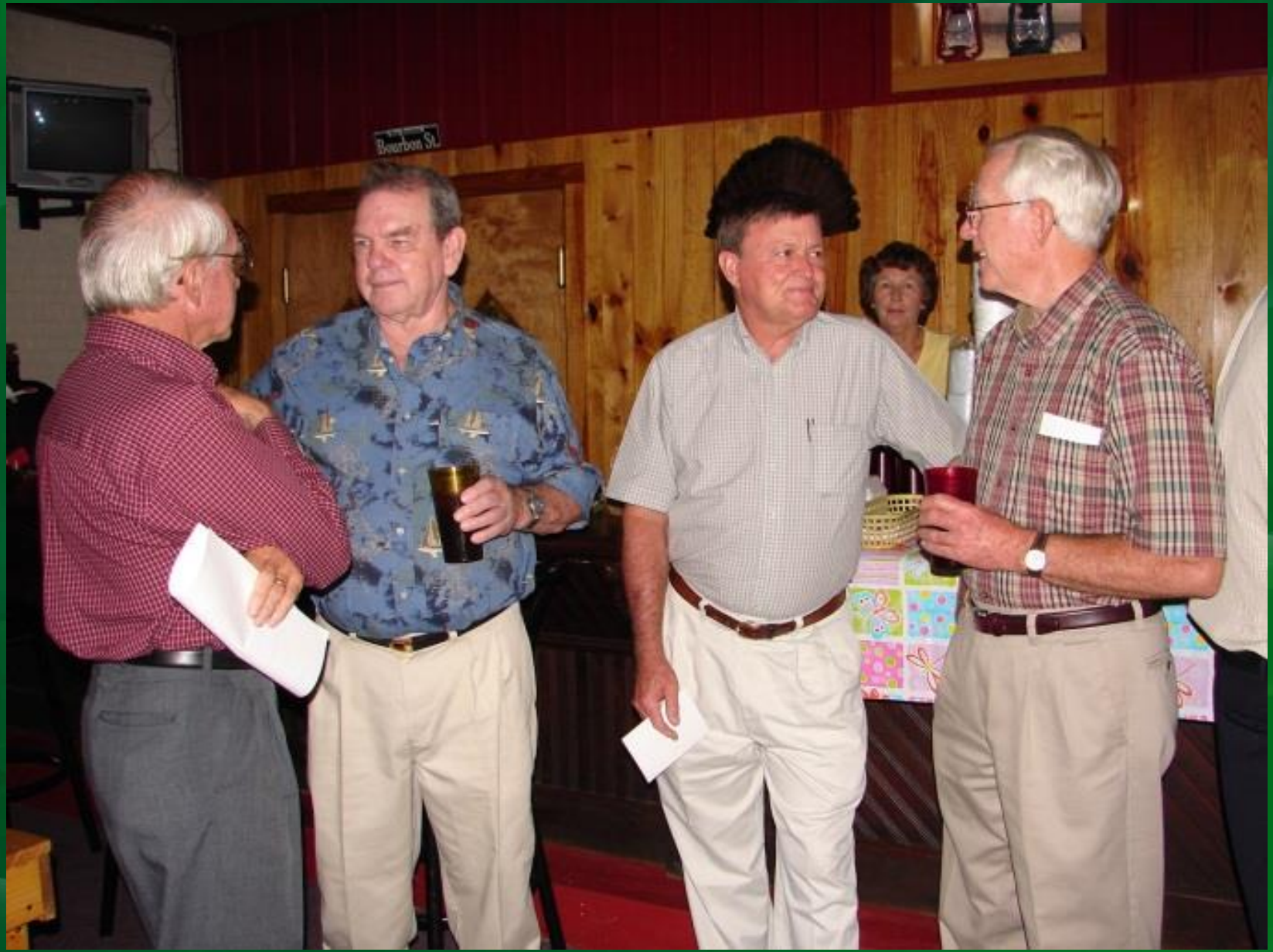

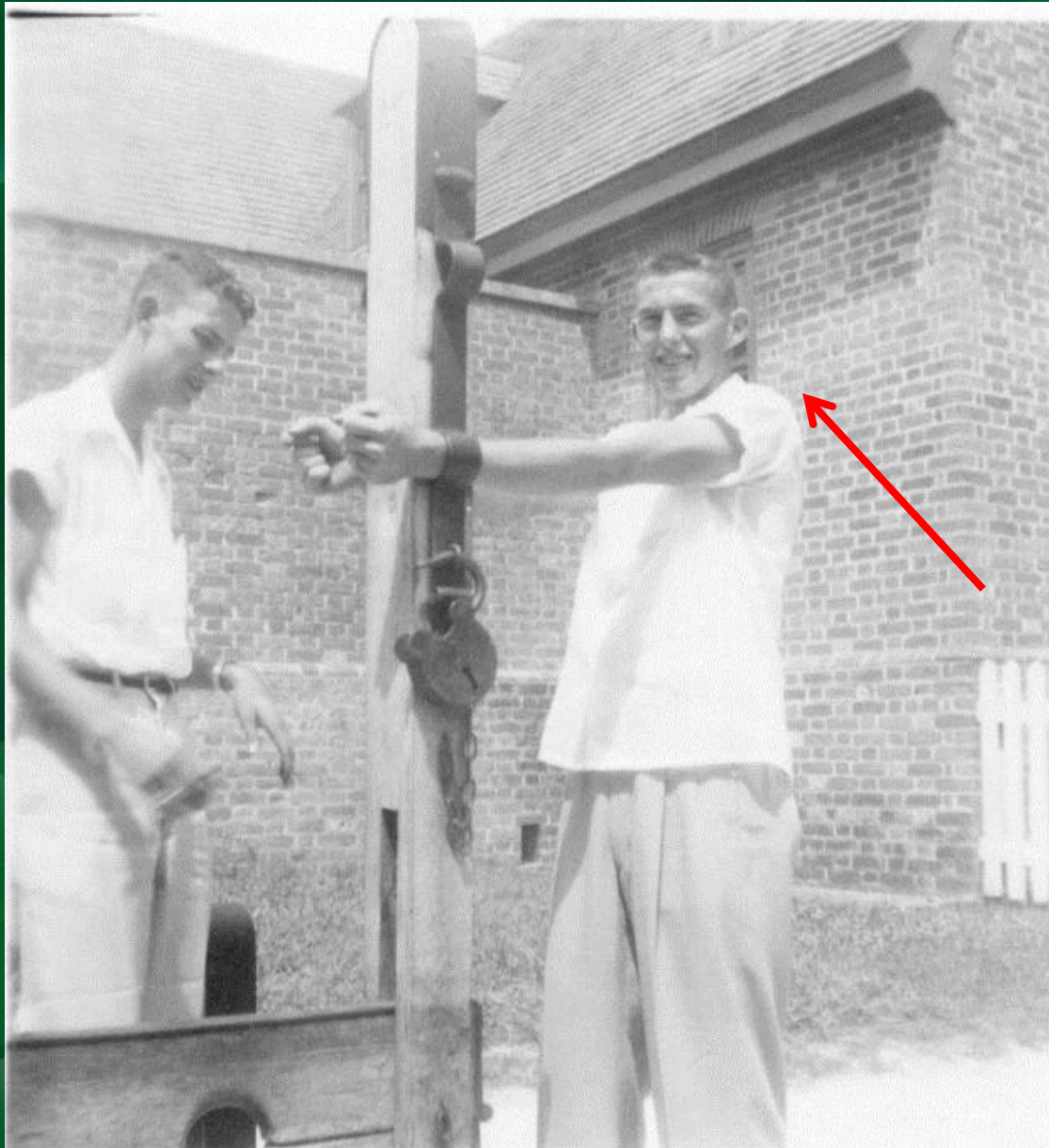

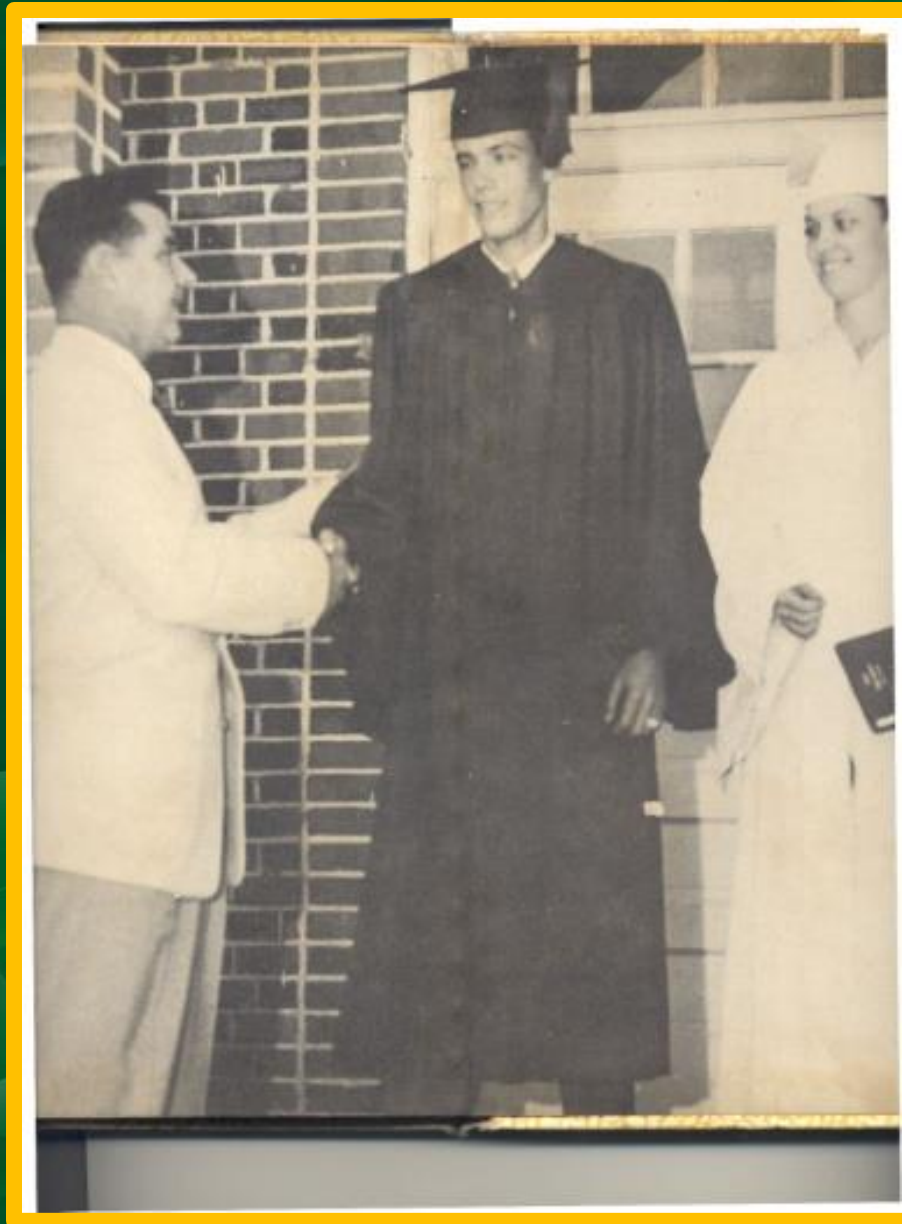
